# Family style

**Jenny Blanc** credits her grandmother with helping to develop her sense for what makes a beautiful home. “She had impeccable taste and style. Her house [in Epsom, England] was full of the most beautiful furnishings down to the last detail,” she recalls. Today, Blanc is a sought-after designer working in the UK and Caribbean – often for clients who have homes in both and who love her ability to imagine rooms that, as she puts it, “flow seamlessly from one to the next, creating a peaceful and comfortable atmosphere.” Blanc set up her design practice in 1996, but already had a portfolio that included the renowned Le Manoir aux Quat’Saisons, which she founded with chef Raymond Blanc. Her team now not only creates design schemes for clients’ homes, but also produces two furniture collections to put in them (one for hot climes, one for cooler). “We also source furniture, rugs, artwork, and mirrors from around the globe to complete our projects.”
